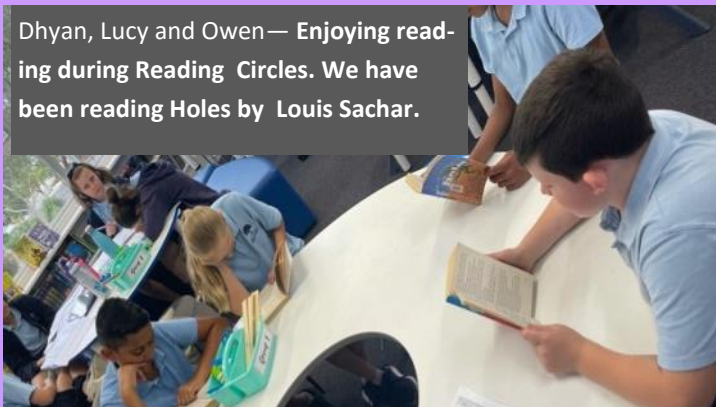
Ally, Hannah and Aiva - Searching for key words and preparing to write information reports.



Lithuki— Learning all about secret ballots in Civics and Citizenship.



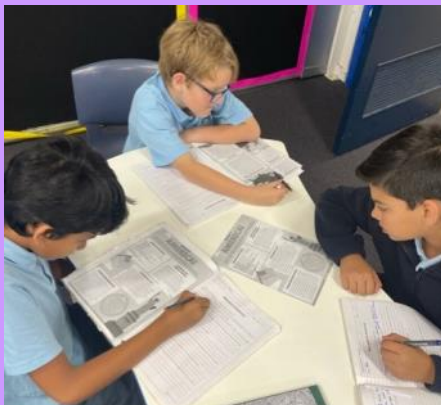
Mikey, Albertina and Rutu—Recording observation after conducting experiment with different liquids in Science.



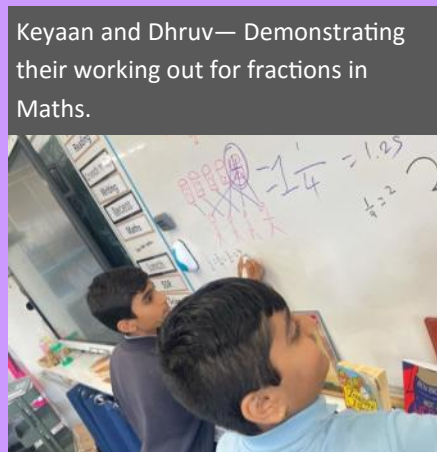
Dhyhan, Lucy and Owen — Enjoying reading during Reading Circles. We have been reading Holes by Louis Sachar.



Albertina, Lucy, Kayla, Nikita and Aiva — Working hard to design their poster on fractions and representing each fraction in different ways.



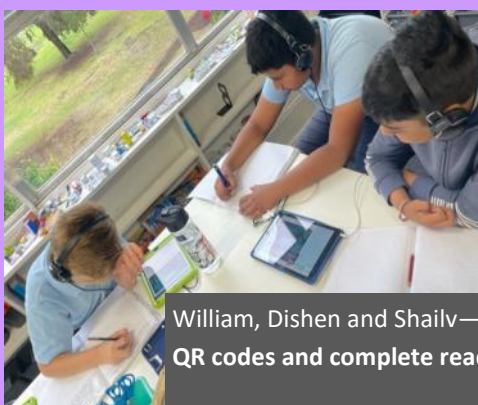
Aarush, Mikey and Alif— Focussed on the reading comprehension activity during reading circles.
