YOUR PATH INTO UNI

There are many pathways and entry options to help high performing athletes get into uni. Whether you're about to start your HSC, are finishing Year 12 or looking to get back into study after a break, we'll help you find the pathway or entry that's right for you.

EARLY ENTRY PROGRAM

Our Early Entry program means Year 12 students can receive an offer from us before commencing the HSC. Offers are contingent on completion of HSC. FREE to apply

SCHOOLS RECOMMENDATION SCHEME

Schools Recommendations Scheme (SRS) offers early entry based on your Year 11 results and recommendation from your school.

YEAR 12 SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT

Our Year 12 Subject Spotlight program rewards you with an offer for your hard work and strong results in English (Standard or Advanced) plus at least one HSC subject related to your degree. There is no separate applications for this program – simply apply via UAC and we will do the rest.

ATAR AND SELECTION RANK

You may be eligible for up to 12 adjustment points. Your selection rank is your ATAR plus any adjustment points.

OPEN FOUNDATION	YAPUG
FREE pathway program for people who do not have the qualifications required for direct entry into an undergraduate degree program.	FREE pathway program for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to gain entry into undergraduate degrees.
DIPLOMAS	ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PROGRAM
Our credit-based diplomas are designed to provide you with a more supported start to uni study.	This program supports Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students to gain entry into our degrees.
TAFE GUARANTEED ENTRY	INDIGENOUS EARLY ENTRY SCHEME (LAW)
You can gain guaranteed entry into many of our undergraduate programs if you have previously completed an accredited Certificate IV, Diploma, or Advanced Diploma at TAFE or another registered training organisation (RTO).	This gives Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students an opportunity to gain early entry to our Bachelor of Laws (Honours) combined degree.
USING YOUR TAFE QUALIFICATION FOR ENTRY	REFUGEE EARLY ENTRY SCHEME (LAW)
We recognise your TAFE qualifications as an equivalent estimated ATAR which you can use to gain entry into our enabling pathways.	This gives students with refugee status an opportunity to gain early entry into our Bachelor of Laws (Honours) combined degree.
