Scholarships

Introduction

Thank you for your interest in Lindisfarne Anglican Grammar School's scholarship program for the 2027 school year.

Each year, Lindisfarne offers a limited number of scholarships, under the following categories:

- Academic Scholarships - Entry in Year 5, Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11.
- General Excellence Scholarships - Entry in Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11.
- Music Scholarships - Entry in Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11.
- Sport Scholarships - Entry in Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11.

Lindisfarne also offers the following Scholarship categories:

- Principal's Scholarships - Entry in Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11**
- Indigenous Scholarships - Entry in Year 7 to Year 11 (Please note that you do not apply for an Indigenous Scholarship via this process, please contact enrolments@lindisfarne.nsw.edu.au for application details).

Scholarships offered by Lindisfarne Anglican Grammar School are awarded after the School receives the results of the Edutest Scholarship Exam to be held on **Saturday, 14 February 2026**. Lindisfarne scholarships are offered following review of the exam results, plus the student's portfolio and an interview (if required) with the Principal or his delegate.

Scholarships are offered for the duration of the student's education at Lindisfarne, subject to a satisfactory annual review. This review is conducted for all scholarship recipients. Scholarship amounts can vary, with up to 75% off the tuition component of the school fee account. This is at the discretion of the Principal and is supported by a panel review.

Students who receive the benefit of a scholarship are expected to fully participate in the life of the School and to undertake curriculum and co-curricular studies and opportunities in support of their scholarship.

Applications

STEP 1. CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT

STEP 2. Register for the Edutest Scholarship Exam - [Edutest Registration Link](#).

The cost of the Edutest Scholarship Exam is \$125.00 per student.

Please note: Edutest registrations close on Friday, 6 February 2026. **Your Scholarship application is deemed incomplete if you do not register for the exam with Edutest.**

STEP 3. All applicants should then complete the Scholarship Application Form.

Scholarship applications also close on Friday, 6 February 2026.

Applications can be made in more than one Scholarship category.

STEP 4. Attend the scholarship exam held at the Mahers Lane campus of Lindisfarne Anglican Grammar School on **Saturday, 14 February 2026**. There is no alternate testing date scheduled. Applicants are politely requested to make this date a priority.

STEP 5. Students are required to hand in their checklist and supporting documentation on Scholarship Testing Day. Refer to the Supporting Documentation Information section below for requirements.

STEP 6. Wait to be advised by email of the results and outcome of the Scholarship process. This will be by the end of Term 1, 2026. As it is an extremely busy time for the Enrolments team, we request that you wait to receive the results email.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students who are unsuccessful in receiving a Scholarship will be considered for a general enrolment place based upon the date of their Enrolment Application, as per our Enrolment Policy.

An application for a Scholarship is **NOT** an application for enrolment. Successful Scholarship applicants will also be required to complete an enrolment application.

Specific Scholarship Requirements

Academic Scholarships

Students are required to undertake the independent academic examination (Edutest). A high level of academic ability is required. Students should support their application with evidence of academic achievement.

Eligibility: Students entering Years 5, 7, 9 and 11 in 2027.

General Excellence Scholarships

Students are required to take the independent academic examination (Edutest) and submit evidence of their areas of strength via a portfolio outlining a high level in at least **three** of the following interest areas:

- Academic Achievement
- Leadership and Community Service
- Music
- Creative Arts
- Speech/Drama
- Sport — representative or state level
- Other supporting documentation is required.

Eligibility: Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11 in 2027.

Sport Scholarships

Students must take the independent academic examination (Edutest) and submit portfolio evidence of sporting achievement. A high-level of sport achievement is required (eg State-level or above). Please note that students who receive a Sport Scholarship do not gain automatic entry to the Lindisfarne Sports Academy.

Eligibility: Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11 in 2027.

Music Scholarships

Students are required to undertake the independent academic examination (Edutest) to a satisfactory level. Students will need to provide evidence of their current level of music ability and may be invited by the Director of Music for an audition. Applicants should at least be AMEB level 4 or higher. (Or an equivalent level in Trinity or the like).

Applicants for a Music Scholarship who have been requested to audition will be contacted by the Music Faculty to arrange the date and time for their Music audition. Please note this will NOT be on the same day as the Edutest examination.

Students will be required to prepare two contrasting pieces of no longer than three minutes per piece and should be prepared to undertake a short sight-reading test, some aural testing, and a short musicianship test. No accompanist is required for auditions.

Eligibility: Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11 in 2027.

**Principal's Scholarships

Principal's Scholarship applications are submitted in conjunction with either an Academic, General Excellence, Music or Sport Scholarship application. Students are required to undertake the independent academic examination (Edutest).

Principal's Scholarships are awarded on the above, but are means-tested. They are designed to support applicants with limited financial means. Applicants may be asked to provide additional information demonstrating limited capacity to meet Lindisfarne's fee structure. To apply use the Academic Scholarship application form.

Eligibility: Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11 in 2027.

Supporting Documentation Information

This is the evidence detailing student achievement in support of the application. Applications are not returned. Please DO NOT include original copies of documents.

A separate set of documents for each scholarship category is required.

Documents must be grouped by one bulldog clip printed on A4 paper. No staples, folders or plastic sleeves are permitted.

Checklist

Each scholarship category applied for requires a separate checklist. See previous pages for links.

Letter to the Principal - Student

This handwritten letter is from the student detailing the reasons why they would like to be considered for a Lindisfarne scholarship.

Letter to the Principal - Parent/Guardian

This letter is from the parent/guardian in support of the application. This is an opportunity to highlight student achievement and add any further information you would like the Principal and Scholarship Review Panel to be aware of.

School Reports

Semester One 2025 and Semester Two 2025 school reports.

NAPLAN Results

Most recent NAPLAN results. NAPLAN is held for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. Results can be obtained from the school where the student sat the exam. Schools are sent a copy for their records. If your student did not sit NAPLAN because they were living overseas or were at a school where it was not offered, please include a page with a brief explanation.

Portfolio of Evidence

This is required for students applying for General Excellence, Music or Sport Scholarships.

General Excellence Applications

Academic Achievement Category
Please provide:

- A statement outlining your child's academic engagement and achievements, including:
 - Participation in extension or enrichment programs (e.g. Aurora College, Gateways, Gifted and Talented programs).
 - Involvement in academic competitions (e.g. Maths Olympiad, Tournament of Minds, ICAS, Days of Excellence) and any results or outcomes.
 - Recognition through academic awards or distinctions, with the year achieved.
- Supporting evidence including certificates, competition results, reports, or program documentation.

Leadership and Community Service Category
Please provide:

- A statement outlining your child's demonstration of leadership, initiative, and service to others through school or community roles, such as:
 - School-based positions - SRC, Class Captain, Library Leader, Sports Captain, House Captain, School Captain, etc. (include years held).
 - Community involvement - volunteering with local organisations, youth programs, church or charity work, or other community initiatives.
 - Examples of reliability, teamwork, and contribution to the life of the School and wider community.
- Supporting evidence: certificates, photos, or letters of participation.

Music, Arts, Speech & Drama, Sport Categories

Please provide:

- A statement outlining your child's involvement in co-curricular activities both within and beyond the School, including:
 - Sport - clearly name the sport, competition, and level of achievement (e.g. NCIS, CIS, Zone, Regional, State, or National). Include the year, team name, and representative level.
 - Music, Performing Arts, and Speech and Drama - include the instrument(s) played, AMEB or equivalent grade level, years of study, choirs or ensembles joined, and performance experience.
 - Other Activities - e.g. debating, public speaking, coding, visual arts, or cultural programs.
- Supporting evidence: certificates, programs, ensemble lists, photos, or coach/teacher references.

Music Applications

Please provide:

- A statement outlining your child's achievements in music both within and beyond the School, including:
 - The instrument(s) played, AMEB or equivalent grade level, years of study, choirs or ensembles joined, and performance experience.
- Supporting evidence including certificates, competition results, reports, or program documentation.

Sport Applications

Please provide:

- A statement outlining your child's achievements in sport, including:
 - competitions and level of achievement (e.g. State, or National). Include the year, team name, and representative level.
- Supporting evidence including: certificates, competition results, newspaper articles, photos, or coach references.

Scholarship Day Information

The Edutest Scholarship Exam is conducted at Lindisfarne Anglican Grammar School, 86 Mahers Lane, Terranora NSW. Students must be signed in at Ngahriyah (follow directional signage to park on the bottom oval) promptly between 8.30am - 8.45am NSW daylight savings time. Parents can remain on site if required, see below.

Parents are to arrive to collect students from Ngahriyah at 12.30pm NSW daylight saving time. Parents, please note that the finish time may vary so please plan accordingly. Students may dress in comfortable casual clothing and footwear and do not have to wear their current school uniform.

Students are required to bring the following items on the day:

- Two 2B or HB pencils.
- Black or blue pen.
- Eraser.
- Sharpener.
- Morning tea and a drink (in a clearly named bag).

All examination equipment must be in a clear pencil case or the equivalent.

Results and Notification

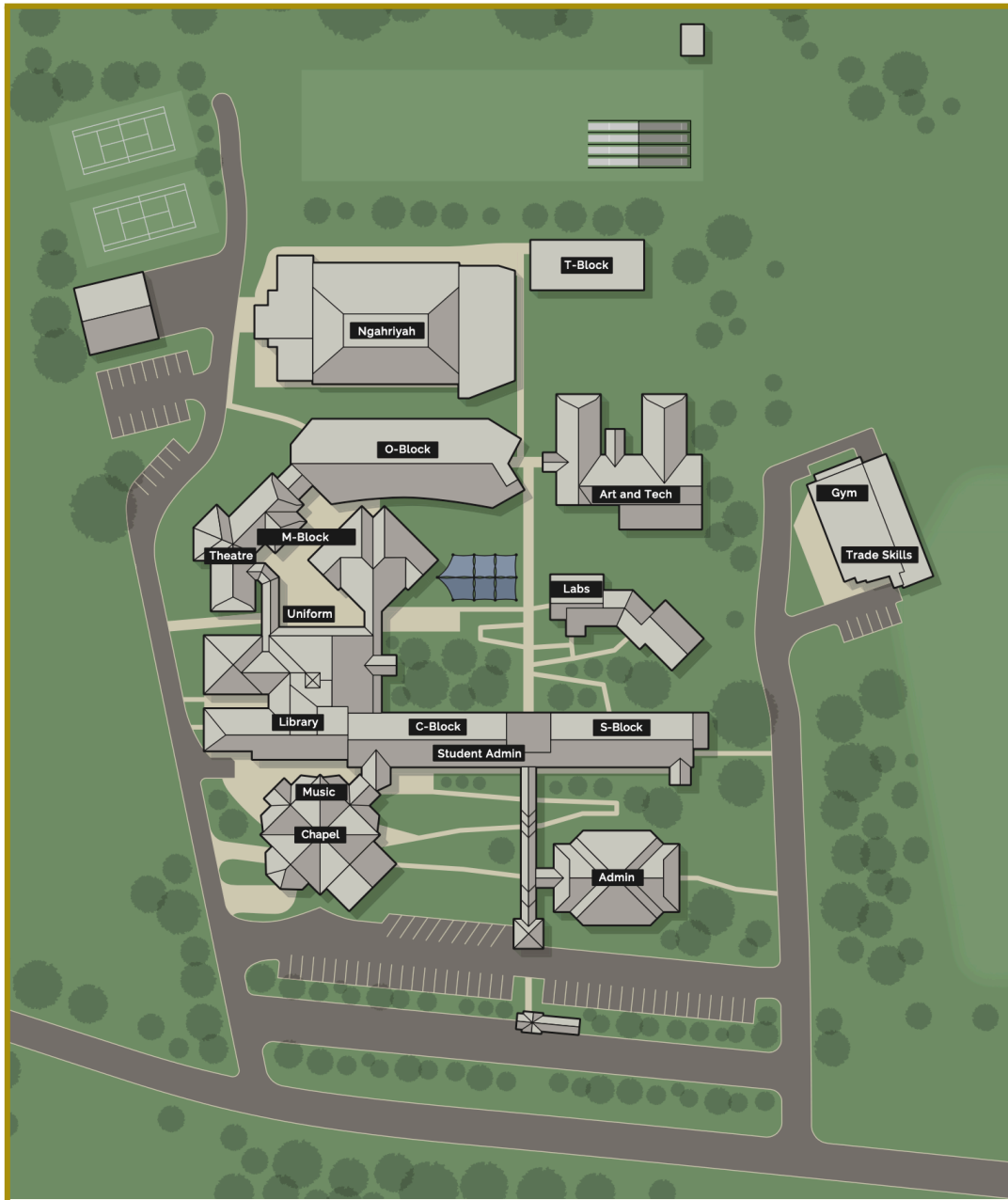
Following the examination, the Scholarship Panel led by the Principal will review all scholarship applications. Applicants will be notified via email of the outcome of the scholarship by the end of Term 1, 2026. Following this notification, Edutest results will be made available to parents via email request. Scholarships are finalised following an interview with the Principal or delegate.

Parents are reminded that a Scholarship application is NOT an Enrolment application. We strongly recommend you accompany your Scholarship application with an Enrolment application if you are not a current student or you have not submitted an Enrolment application previously.

Scholarship Day - Parent Information

Parents and students should assemble in Ngahriyah promptly between 8.30am - 8.45am NSW daylight saving time. Please refer to the Lindisfarne School map below. Follow the signs and parking will be available on the bottom oval.

A school tour will be available for parents at 9.00am while the students are in the exam. Ngahriyah will remain open should any parents wish to remain on-site for the duration of the exam.
