Chrysocephalum 'CAP07' (L) Intended

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

An Australian wildflower that survives where others don't.

- Yellow buttons that thrive when others don't
- Stolons spread and help it bounce back from stress
- Survives drought, frost and flooding



Description This *Chrysocephalum* has stolons that spread and bounce back from conditions other wildflowers struggle. It's a complete game-changer for Aussie landscapes.

Density 3-6 per sq m or 4 per linear metre

Height & Width 200mm H(foliage) 350mm H(flowers) x 500mm W

Flowering Vibrant yellow flowers for most of the year feed native pollinators, while seeds feed other beneficial insects and more.

Best Planting Time Late winter to spring

Uses Native ground cover, biodiversity support, retaining walls, containers. Supports warm color palettes.

Position Full sun to light shade. Tolerant of frost and drought.

Soil Type Most soils, including periodic wet, but looks best with adequate drainage.

Care Allow damaged leaves to protect roots in drought or frost. Prune back when conditions improve.
