ENROLMENT FEES

A non-refundable Application Fee of \$100 per child is payable upon application of enrolment.

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees are billed each Term and are payable by the specified due date, unless a payment plan arrangement is in place with the Finance Department.

A 5% discount applies to tuition fees if the annual payment is made in full, by the due date of your first statement.

1. The College Policy is to provide an all-inclusive Tuition Fee, which includes subject levies, excursions, curriculum, compulsory camps, graduation, student accident insurance and general level ICT access and support.
2. Tuition fees for Years 5 to 12 also include a Technology levy for the provision of ICT support for the 1:1 program.
3. Non-Compulsory College camps will be advised by the relevant teaching staff and billed separately. Refer to the Terms and Conditions for further details.



BUS FEES

Parents are required to complete the Bus Transport Application Form. Full time bookings have preference.

Casual Trips - \$7.50 each way, subject to availability. Must be paid upfront as casual trips cannot be put on account.

Bus fees are billed each term on the family fee account and are due at the same time as tuition fees, unless an approved payment plan is in place. Bus fees are non-refundable and cannot be pro-rated as they are charged at a flat fee per term.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

APPLICATION FEE

A \$100 non-refundable Application Fee applies to each new student and is payable upon application.

SCHOOL FEES

- School Fees are adjusted annually to reflect the Average Government School Recurrent Cost.
- All students are covered under our Student Accident Protection plan, forming part of our fees.
- **Inclusions:** teaching, general learning support, textbooks, subject materials, excursions, general co-curricular sport, College competition fees, and compulsory camps.
- **Exceptions:** Student stationery, certain co-curricular sport opportunities (e.g. futsal) and non-compulsory camps. Please note: these kinds of activities will be communicated as and when required.

PAYMENTS

- Non-payment of Fees ultimately results in the termination of an enrolment. Regular communication and demonstrated effort are required if difficulties occur.
- Financial hardship is considered in special circumstances and needs to be formally discussed with the Finance Department.
- Families can elect to pay weekly, fortnightly, monthly, by term or annually.
- Where an account is outside the payment terms a student may not be eligible to attend major school trips and/or extra-curricular activities.

DISCOUNTS

- The College offers a 5% discount on Annual Tuition Fees provided the payment is made as a lump sum up front payment by the first invoice's due date.
- Scholarships and Bursaries are available to eligible families in accordance with College Policy.

BUILDING FUND

- The College depends on the support of the College community to continue in the development of facilities for all students.
- Tax Deductible Donations to the Riverside Christian College Building Fund can be made voluntarily at any time.

CAMPS & EXCURSIONS

- Camps & excursions are a compulsory part of the College curriculum for certain grade levels. Most are included in the tuition fees or are heavily subsidised by the College.
- The Non-Compulsory College camps are quite substantial and although the College does subsidise these costs, there will be an extra cost billed to families. This information and costing will be provided prior to the trip.

TEXTBOOKS

- Textbook hire and readers are included in school fees and are issued from the library.
- Lost or damaged textbooks will be billed to the family at replacement cost.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- Electronic devices are issued to students from Years 5 to 12 once the ICT Maintenance of Effort Program 'Acceptable Use of Technology and Social Media Policy' has been signed and returned to the College.
- The cost of these electronic devices are included in the tuition fees and remain the property of the College.
- The College accepts no liability for any loss or damage to personal effects of property of any student.

UNIFORMS

- Approved Riverside Christian College Uniforms can be purchased through College Uniform Shop.
- Price lists can be obtained via the College website or from the College Main Office.
- Uniforms must be paid for upfront and cannot be put on account.

CREATIVE ARTS TUITION

- The College provides the opportunity for students to receive instrumental or speech tuition during school time.
- To take advantage of this opportunity, families must communicate directly with the instructor as this tuition is not associated with College accounts.

BUS SERVICE

- Riverside Christian College provides an excellent and safe Bus service transporting students to and from the College.
- All new bookings or variations to bookings must be made through the RollCall App.
- Seating on the bus is subject to availability, and seating priority will be given to full-time users.
- Students will only be able to use the Bus as per the bookings applied for, and as approved by the Bus Coordinator.
- Bus Bookings will roll over from term to term unless notified otherwise.
- Bus Fees are a flat fee per term. Any changes or non-usage will not be entitled to a credit, refund or pro-rata - including year levels that finish earlier in the year.
- Bus Fees are non-refundable.
- All parents are required to use the College Bus App RollCall.

EXTERNAL SPORT

- Some external sports training is offered before/after school on College grounds.
- Fees for these external sports are to be paid as instructed when registering

SCHOOL PHOTOS

- Payment for school photos is to be paid directly to the photography company.

EXTERNAL VET COURSES

- External courses can be arranged through the College.
- Fees for approved external courses will be charged directly to the family by the course provider.

INTERNAL VET COURSES

- Internal VET courses can be arranged through the College RTO (RTO No: 45550).
- Certificate III in Agriculture is \$500 for the 2 year course. All other courses are at no additional cost to the family in 2023. VET Course Fees will be increased in 2024.
- Fees for internal VET courses are billed annually up-front on parent accounts. Course fees are due in the same time frame as tuition fees.
- Withdrawals prior to Friday of Week 5, Term 1 will attract an 80% refund of VET course fees.
- Course fees are non-refundable after Friday Week 5 of Term 1.
- Families with a demonstrated history of paying fees on time may apply to have a payment plan

for VET Courses. Payment plans must be settled by the end of Term 1.

- Application must be made to accounts@riverside.qld.edu.au and will be reviewed by the Finance Manager.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT - PARENT

- It is a condition of enrolment that one Term's notice (**10 school term weeks**) is required, in writing, addressed to the Enrolments Officer prior to exiting the College.
- Failure to provide the required notice will result in One Term's fees being charged to or withheld from the account.
- The Principal, at their sole discretion, may agree to remit payment, in lieu of notice, in full or partially.
- Bus Fees are non-refundable.
- Credits are not transferrable to purchase Uniforms.
- Voluntary Camps and excursions may not be refunded due to activities being organised and purchased by the College in advance.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT - COLLEGE

- The Principal determines the rules, regulations and policies of the College.
- Parent(s) will seek to ensure the adherence to these rules and ensure the good behaviour of any student they have enrolled at the College.
- Any student may be required to leave the College at the end of a term if, in the opinion of the Principal, the students attitude to work or behaviour is unsatisfactory, committed a serious breach of discipline or an act affecting the reputation of the College.
- The College may take legal action to recover outstanding accounts without notice. Parent(s) agree to indemnify the College against debt collection costs and disbursements incurred because of outstanding accounts.
- The College may amend the terms of the fee schedule and will take steps it considers reasonable to give notice of such changes to parent(s).
